## CHEROKEE NATION TAX COMMISSION AFFIDAVIT OF ASSEMBLY AND OWNERSHIP

### PURPOSE:

To be used when major components, that normally have VIN plates, are taken from two or more vehicles or motorcycles to title as one roadworthy vehicle or motorcycle. A combination or new components with MSO's wand used components with titles or bills of sale may be used to make one roadworthy motorcycle.

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### FOR A COMBINATION OF TWO OR MORE VEHICLES

If the body and cab came from different vehicles, they must be listed separately. List the frame separately.

<b>Major Components:</b>	This should include parts that have the VIN number of the vehicle it was taken from; IE dash, doors, engine, transmission, etc...
<b>Description:</b>	Enter year, make, and model of the vehicle the components came from.
<b>Purchased from:</b>	Enter the name of the seller (if the seller was a business, give the name of the business).
<b>Address:</b>	Enter the street, city, and state of seller.
<b>Vehicle ID Number:</b>	Enter the VIN number of the vehicle the components came from.
<b>Amount:</b>	Enter the purchase price for the component and amount figured for labor. Add the amounts of components and labor for the grand total. Original (notarized), titles, bills of sale and/or similar documents must accompany this application.

#### FOR ASSEMBLY OF A MOTORCYCLE

List all components that were used to build the motorcycle. Original (notarized) MSO's, titles, bills of sales, and/or similar documents must accompany this application for the, frame, motor, transmission, front end, wheels, tires, fenders, gas tank, seat, handlebars, and odometer. Complete each column in the same manner as for a vehicle.

#### FOR ASSEMBLY OF A KIT

List every major component that came with the kit to show how complete the kit is. List all major components that were used to build that vehicle. Complete each column for each entry in the same manner as above. Original (notarized), MSO's, titles, bills of sale, and/or similar documents must accompany this application.

*Note: Replacement of a motor, transmission or similar component does not require the use of this form.*
